Civilized or Barbaric?

She was a nurse at Christ Hospital in Oak Lawn, Illinois in the late 1990’s working on the labor and delivery floor. One night she was in her meeting for the shift

working at a Christian hospital these procedures would not be performed. Jill would come to find out this would be just the first of many induced-labor abortions that would occur here. This evening turned into a life changing moment for Jill. The doctor conducted the induced-labor abortion, and the baby was born alive. The parents did not want to hold the baby while he died and the nurse who was assisting did not have time to hold the baby either, so she placed the baby in a utility closet to die by himself. Jill was so upset with this that she went into the utility closet and held the baby boy for 45 minutes while he passed away. After the baby had passed Jill carried him to the morgue. Jill talked to other nurses that had horror stories of alive babies being taken away to the utility room again and again after induced-labor abortion. One nurse remembered a baby girl who lived for 8-1/2 hours after she was born alive. Again, no NICU team called in to save her life; she was just taken to the utility closet to die. Jill tried writing a letter to the management team of Christ Hospital and they called her into a meeting telling her that they are doing the most humane thing possible for the babies that are born alive after an induced-labor abortion. Jill knew that speaking out would have consequences, but she knew what was going on with these alive babies was wrong and it needed to be stopped. After many failed attempts to try to get the hospital to change its mind Jill's story hit the media. It took sometime but on "August 5, 2002, President George W. Bush invited Jill to his signing of the Born-Alive Infants Protection Act, which defines children who survive an abortion attempt as people who deserve the same medical care as any other baby." On November 5, 2003,

President Bush signed the "Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act, which protects partially delivered babies from being killed by abortion. You see this practice IS barbaric, but it just took one brave soul to stand up for the voiceless!
